Here is a list of some of the best kept secrets of the Four-County Region

Allen's Fillin Station at the corner of Main and Commerce in Commerce, OK a recently restored old gas station now houses a small petroliana museum

Dobson Museum 110 A St SW Museum Miami, OK ~ 918-542-5297 which has Native American artifacts a collection of china, glassware, an extensive jug collection as well as a display of furniture and toys used by first settlers. Exhibits provide insight to Oklahoma's mining legacy

Miami, OK also has the Route 66 Vintage Iron Motorcycle Museum ~ 918-542-6170 Located on Historic Route 66 this museum is a must see for motorcycle enthusiast and Steve McQueen fans a collection of 25 Vintage motorcycles a 1917 Harley-Davidson and the only 1919 GCS in existence, an Australian make, as well as Steve McQueen's motorcycles and memorabilia.

Jay, OK has the Delaware County Historical Society Mariee Wallace Museum located a 538 Krause St. Downtown Jay, Ok ~ 928-253-4345.

Colcord, OK has the Talbot Library & Museum 500 S. Colcord Ave 918-326-4532. They have many interesting items to view including the Springtown School House, General Store, The Farm Equip Building, Blacksmith Shop, and don't forget their Genealogy and Historical Research Library.

The Afton Station & Route 66 Packards Museum at 1st & Locust Afton, OK has a Antique Car Museum, Route 66 Museum and Gift Shop. 918-257-4044

In Pryor at 8th & US-69S you will find the Coo-Y-Yah Museum ~ 918-825-2222 which houses Cherokee & Osage Indian history, art, local history, rare salt-glazed pottery collection 1800 printing press & 1942 tornado exhibit

Willard Stone Family Museum & Gallery which contains 150 wood sculptures, bronzes and sketches by the world-renounced artist of Cherokee descent ~ 918-386-2329

Chouteau Memorial Museum at 420 E Ferry St Salina, OK ~ 918-434-2224 Were you can view the history of fur trade from 1790s – 1830s Osage Tribal influence, an emphasis on the Chouteau family, Indian Territory & The Three Forks Region

Eastern Trails Museum 215 W Illinois Vinita, OK ~ 918-256-2115 has a recreated post office, general store, printing office, doctor's office, indian history & railroad & military items
